- 4) Whom do you think is the hero of this book? (I think that there is more than one choice) (Book Companion and RTS)
- 5) Would you invest in a fund run by Bill Browder? Why or why not? (Book Companion and RTS)
- 6) Do you feel the book was well written? How do you think Browder presents himself as a person?

- 7) Do you believe the book fairly and accurately represents the facts? (Book Companion)
- 8) Bill Browder goes from stating that a “ten bagger” (tenfold increase in the value of an investment) as being the greatest feelgood moment he could experience to saying that the success in passing the Magnitsky act supplants the ten bagger as the provider of the best feelings.
